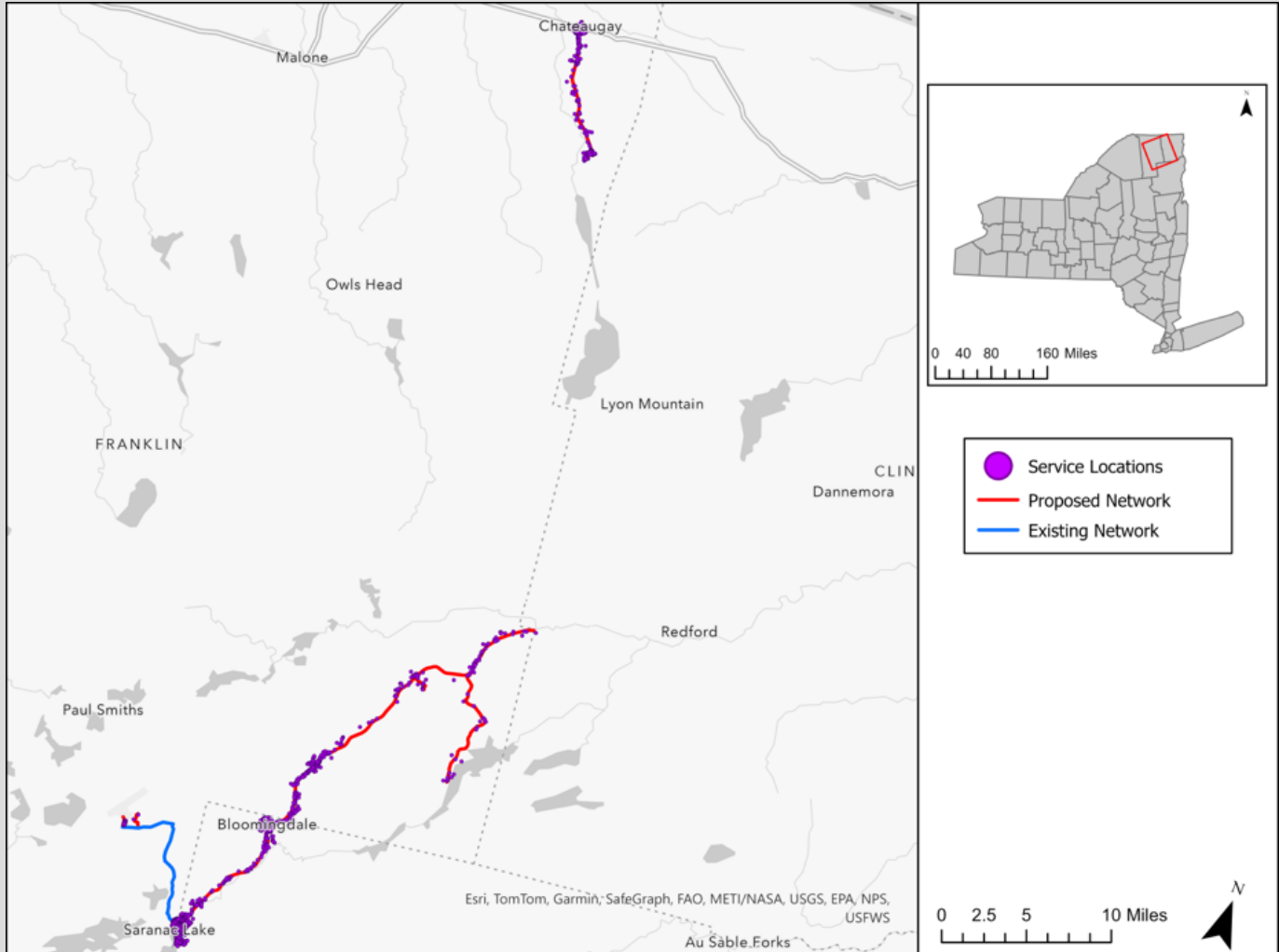

Project Summary

The Franklin County project will reach more than 1,600 homes and businesses, including many of the hardest to reach unserved locations in the County, navigating around natural wetlands, areas with no utility service, and areas that already have fiber optic infrastructure. Franklin County will work with the Development Authority of the North Country, which has two decades of experience managing public fiber optic infrastructure, to build 36 miles of open access fiber to the utility poles along the locations to be served. SLICFiber, a private internet service provider, will be responsible for the drop to connect the homes and businesses with capacity in the network to support additional providers. The project will allow remote residents to access telehealth services and engage in remote work.
